**TSHP Local Chapter Challenge** ★ **The Best of TSHP, Local Chapters Shine** During the 2017-2018 year, all eleven TSHP local affiliate chapters were challenged to increase their membership renewals, as well as new member growth. The challenge created quite a bit of competition between the chapters, but in the end, only 2 winners could be named the “Best of TSHP.” **El Paso Area Society of Health-System Pharmacists** took home the Membership Growth Award and **Austin Area Society of Health-System Pharmacists** won top Exceptional Retention! The winning chapters received a \$500 educational grant or 1 complementary TSHP Annual Seminar registration (up to \$625 value), plus use of the “Best of TSHP” logo to use in their chapter media and marketing. There were also two sweepstakes winners, chosen at random from those that reached a target goal. The **Goal Achiever Sweepstakes** awardees were **Lubbock Area Society of Health-System Pharmacists** and **Metroplex Society of Health-System Pharmacists** (DFW area). All chapters deserve congratulations on a successful inaugural Chapter Challenge! The 2nd Annual Local Chapter Challenge began July 18.



**Texas College Awarded ASHP Grant** ★ Congratulations to the 2018 Student Society Development Grant Recipients: **University of Texas at El Paso School of Pharmacy** and Binghamton University School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences. ASHP's [Student Society Development Grant Program](#), encourages the development of student societies of health-system pharmacy (SSHPs) in colleges of pharmacy throughout the United States. Grants are intended for use by the ASHP state affiliate and college of pharmacy partners to establish a new SSHP or to strengthen an existing SSHP, and ultimately to aid the SSHP to achieve official national and state Recognition.
