**Packaging Systems Errors Survey** ★ *Members looking for participant feedback.* A survey is being conducted September through November 2019, in collaboration with UT Southwestern Medical Center in Dallas, for different solid drug unit-dose packaging systems. Unit-dose packaging systems are intended to improve dispensing accuracy, increase productivity, and lower overall costs. However, as with any technology, errors are inevitable. The goal of this survey is to gather background data by comparing different institution packaging systems, the types of packing errors that occur, and the processes in place to prevent errors from reaching patients.
